














Jacksonville, FL, Training

[JACKSONVILLE, FL] February 22 - 26, 2016, Len Ministries held an intensive 5-day evangelism training at the Adamec's Harley-Davidson motorcycle building at Baymeadows and I-95 in Jacksonville, FL. The class was from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. It was designed to equip pastors and lay leaders to be able to train their congregations to share their faith and make a big impact in their cities.

The lectures were taught by Rev. Len Showalter, Dwight Preheim, Rev. Al Kaidor, and Helen Adamec. Assisting the training was Cathy Russi with Southpoint Community Church.

Three of the four students were international and the fourth was local: Bishop David Kiptoo (pioneer and founder of Great Glory Ministries based in Eldoret, Kenya), Evangelist Lavern Rutivi (his father is Bishop of 200 churches in and around Nairobi, Kenya), Pastor Robert Mponye (pastor and founder of King's Kid Ministries, Mityana, Uganda), and Carla Bitancor (secretary for the Church of the Messiah, Jacksonville, FL). Pastor Robert stayed at the Showalter's home and David and Lavern were housed at a local hotel.

On Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday after four hours of lectures, the students were taken by the trainers to a local mall in the Baymeadows area for two hours of witnessing. The training yielded 59 contacts and the Gospel was shared 38 times to 44 people resulting in 30 professions/assurances of faith.

At the end of the week, all four students successfully completed the requirements for graduation. A celebration dinner was held at "Go Len Corral" where all the students expressed gratitude for the teaching and for the use of the wonderful facility. They all returned home at the end of the week or at the end of their stay with many stories and plans to immediately start training others.
