Lima, Peru

On Friday, October 20, the team (pictured I-r) of Rusty Bennett, Rev, Len Showalter, Randy Brown, Ruth



Harhi, and Dwight Preheim left Jacksonville, FL for Lima, Peru. This was a mission trip to equip local pastors with an evangelistic tool, Evangelism Explosion (EE), so that they in turn can

equip their congregations to evangelize their cities. (Also

After a seven hour flight from Atlanta, GA the team checked into Maria Angola, a downtown

Lima hotel. After a night's rest and a five block walk they attended an EE clinic that was underway at the Lima



Templo, a Four Square Church. The clinic was held each evening from Friday, 10/20 through Saturday, 10/28. Pastor Fabio Padilla was the main clinic teacher and he is also the EE coordi-

nator for Peru. Rev. Len Showalter and Rev. Guillermo Di



Giovanna, EE Coordinator for Southern South America, also assisted with the teachings.

Pastor Fabio's church was filled with 39 clinic atten-

dees, 25 local trainers, and 5 American trainers.



Additional staff was present to assist with meals and other logistical necessities.

Visitation occurred on three

nights resulting in 66 professions of faith. In addition to ministering in church on Sunday, the team, assisted by

Guillermo and an interpreter, made daily excursions as time permitted. They visited a local hospital, an orphanage, and a home for abused women.



The team was able to deliver gifts and minister the Word of God

one-on-one or in a group in each of these situations as well as with taxi drivers and hotel clerks. An additional 31 professions of Faith were recorded as the team ministered through the



final day. At graduation all 39 national pastors and lay leaders and one American (Dwight Preheim) were certi-

fied to teach EE to their congregations and begin winning their cities for Christ!

Al Kaidor traveled from Jacksonville, FL on October 20 to Manaus, Brazil, and completed 10 days in the Amazon region on a short-



term mission trip with the Southern Baptist Association. He traveled by boat up the Amazon River with 15 other people. They shared the Gospel through interpreters with jungle natives and docu-

mented 285 professions! Al arrived in Buenos Aires at 2




AM on Monday morning and to complete the American team.
