

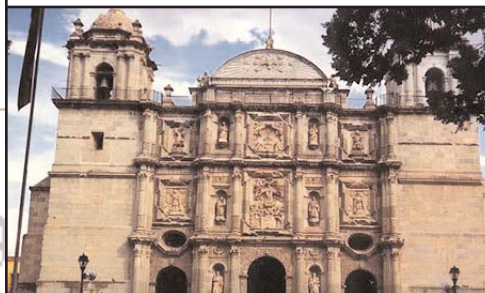

Mission Trips

Len Ministries is planning two short-term mission trips over the next four months. An Evangelism Explosion (EE) Clinic will be conducted for the national pastors on each trip.

The first trip is to Chihuahua, Mexico from April 2 to April 9. There



are over 100 Assembly of God pastors that have requested a clinic be held to equip them in evangelism. There are actually three different groups going to Chihuahua to accomplish this task. Pastor Len is leading the last team.

The second trip is to Nizhny Novgorod, Russia from June 16 to July 2. Pastor Len will be working with the Baptist Union in Nizhny to equip 40 pastors. The Light of Christ Church in Nizhny will also assist with supplying trainers for this clinic. Also, visita-

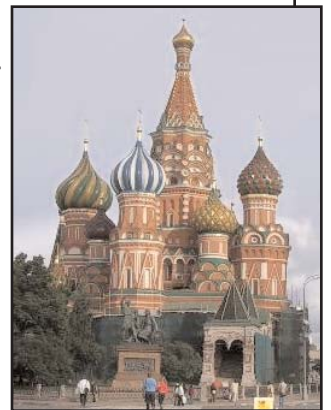
tion will be made to the children in summer camps, schools, and orphanages.

local residents of more than 6,500.

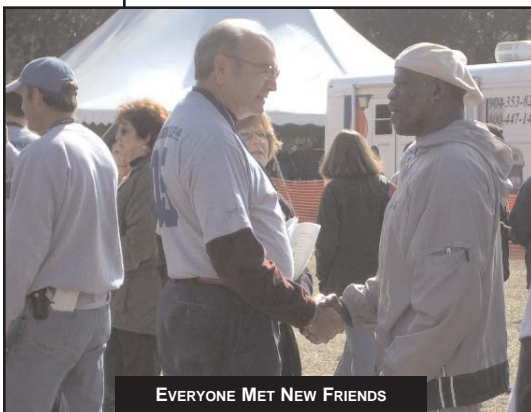
There were over 100 churches and 3,500 volunteers of all denominations participating. Some cooked food, put up tents, and managed

Len Ministries was responsible for the Family Services tent where each person would be presented an opportunity to hear the Gospel.



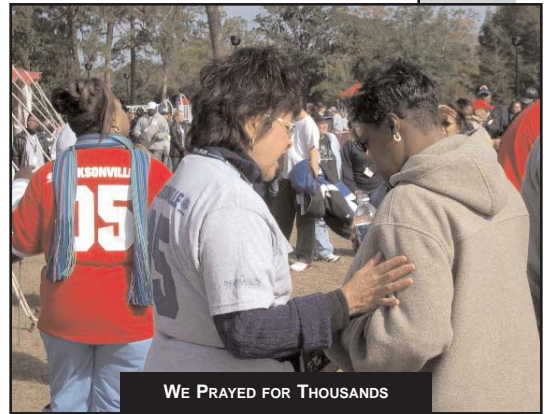
EVERYONE MET NEW FRIENDS
