



On Tuesday January 30, 2007, Rev. Len Showalter and Rusty Bennett left Jacksonville, FL headed for Douala,





KING'S KID SCHOOL HOUSE

Showalter, Rusty Bennett, and Guy Landry arrived in Entebbe, Uganda, located on the beautiful Victoria Lake. They were met by Pastor Robert Mponye. After a quick trip through Kampala, they headed to Mityana which is about 30 miles away. Mityana is a village of 50,000 located at an elevation of 5400 feet.



LIFE HOUSE COMMUNITY CHURCH

Robert and Esther Mponye operate King's Kid Ministry which has an orphanage and school for 120 children. They have 9 children which live with them in their block home. There is no hot water, no running water, no inside toilet, and no kitchen. Food is prepared and water is boiled in a charcoal fire in the garage. The toilets are the normal African latrine in a room outside the house. Water is carried in. Esther is known across Africa for her singing and uses all money received to support the orphanage. Robert is a pastor of Life House Community Church, the largest church in Mityana. He also has a weekly live radio broadcast.


LEN, RUSTY, GUY & 10' TERMITE HILL


70 LEADERS TRAINED

Nine of those in attendance gave their hearts to Jesus. On Wednesday, Len and Rusty headed on a two-day trip back to America and Guy returned to Cameroon, and then home to Russia by the weekend.
