## Ivanovo, Russia

[IVANOVO, RUSSIA] On Thursday, July 4, 2013, Len and Marcia Showalter flew out of Daytona Beach, FL, at 6 A.M. due to last minute flight changes. Pastor Guy Landry met them at the airport in Moscow Friday afternoon after a very quick pass through Passport Control, baggage claim, and immigration.

It was a hot (95 degrees) 5-1/2 hour drive (200 miles) to Ivanovo Christian Center (ICC). The time difference of 8 hours ahead of EST caught up with them and rest was needed. Recuperation continued on Saturday which included some family time with Guy, Galina, and their 5 children.

Sunday began with a wonderful church service at Ivanovo Christian Center with many familiar faces. There was praise and worship, communion, a message from Pastor Len, and a time of prayer for people. After church, Len and Marcia went to the home of Sveta and Anthony (an American from Louisiana now living there) for dinner. It was a great time of fellowship and sharing about our cultures, politics, and God's Word.

Monday, July 8, began early with registration of 16 students. After a brief questionnaire and Gospel presentation, half of the class gained assurance of their salvation! The teaching continued on Tuesday as the weather turned cooler. The class

had increased to 21 students. Len worked with the trainees on their personal testimonies during the morning and Len, Guy, and Marcia taught lessons in the afternoon. After dinner 7 teams of 4 & 5 were sent out to the streets to share the Gospel and returned with 8 professions of faith.

The next day the students were excited and with more teaching they were now prepared to share more. With more trainers available, 10 teams of 3 went to the streets and 25 people professed Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior! Everyone rejoiced over the wonderful results.

Marcia started Thursday with a devotion from Mark 10:13-16 where Jesus blesses the little children. (Typically, Marcia would have visited an orphanage after her devotion, but a law had been passed in the Moscow/Ivanovo area forbidding foreigners visiting the children.) There was a time of prayer for the students and more teaching. With two additional witnessing opportunities during the day there were 43 more professions of faith!

Friday was certification day. Oral and written exams were taken by the students. There were 16 that passed and 5 that need additional training by ICC. After much celebration and gift exchanging, Len, Marcia, and Guy made preparation for the early 5 hour Saturday morning trip to Moscow and 2 hour flight to Ufa.

## Iglino, Russia

[IGLINO, RUSSIA] Saturday, July 12, the day began early with Guy, Len, and Marcia leaving for Moscow at 7:00am. With a 2 hour flight and two additional time zones they arrived to Ufa early evening and were greeted by Tim Lovelace, Go to Nations Ministries and CEO of Global Development.

In addition to being the oil center, Ufa is the Muslim capital for Russia. The team headed to Iglino, a village of 15,000 just 20 minutes away. Go to Nations Ministries has a training center located there where missionaries come for 10 weeks of training.

Len and Marcia stayed in the home of Alexander (Sasha) and Irina, Open Heaven Church members. Guy stayed in the church's rehab center where the missionary interns stay.

Church started at noon on Sunday. The service started with a wonderful testimony by a young woman who previously was an addict, but is now an intern with the missionary organization. Irina led praise and worshipafter which Len preached with Guy interpreting.

On Monday, July 15, registration and teaching began for the class of 4 Americans and 14 Russians with 3 receiving assurance of their salvation! A woman who wanted to be a missionary and two others joined the class on Tuesday bringing the total to 21. After a day of teaching, 7 teams of 3 or 4 went out to a nearby park and to the streets sharing the Gospel

with Muslims, Russian Orthodox, and people who had no faith. 29 people made professions of faith.

Wednesday was filled with more lessons, examples, and instructions how to effectively share the Gospel. That evening 7 teams went out again for 2 hours in the same areas that they had been in the night before. The students shared their testimonies and the Gospel. 12 people received Christ with one-to-one witnessing.

The next day Marcia, Guy, Tim, and Sarah (Tim's daughter), visited an orphanage about an hour away. The orphanage had about 40 children but they were only able to visit with 9, ages 7-12. The team had fun with the children, telling them about life in Florida. Marcia and Guy shared the Gospel and all 9 children prayed to receive Jesus Christ!

When the team returned, the trainees were out in the streets witnessing on their own with the results of 19 people professing their faith in Jesus Christ. That evening they went out again and there were 8 more that professed Jesus Christ as Savior.

Friday was exam day. 15 students passed with 6 needing more training. After the exams, the team took a 6 hour trip to the Urals with Sasha. Saturday the team returned to Moscow. Monday Guy returned to Ivanovo and Len and Marcia returned to the
