They are waiting!



Mwanza, Tanzania

[MWANZA, TANZANIA] Pastor Len left Jacksonville, FL, on Wednesday, September 20, headed to Africa. He had an overnight flight from New York to Amsterdam, and then a daylong flight to Nairobi, Kenya. Pastor George Ambayo met Pastor Len about midnight on Thursday and took him to his home for a 3-hour rest. They got up at 3am and headed back to the airport in Nairobi for Len's next flight to Arusa, Tanzania (Mt. Kilimanjaro). Len was greeted in Arusa by Daniele Yetna, director for LMI Africa. Both then caught a flight arriving just after noon on

Friday in Mwanza, Tanzania, which is located on Lake Victoria. (A total travel time of about 48 hours!) They stayed in Pastor Ahmed & Audrey Ngombo's home and after some rest, they toured Mwanza. On Sunday Daniele preached in their church, the Mwanza Pentecostal Church.

The 5-day evangelism training was held at Mwanza Christian College and Seminary Monday through Friday. Each day consisted of about 6-hours of lectures and 2-hours of practicum on the streets. Each night the students had memorizing to accomplish in preparation for the next day. By the fourth day the students were to have the presentation fully memorized and then on the fifth day they took oral and written exams. Through Friday the class had witnessed 413 professions of faith and eight students were certified to continue the teaching of evangelism in their local church.

During the week of training several events stood out: 1) Daniele was able to visit two different primary schools where 300+ children heard the Gospel and prayed to receive Jesus. 2) Len was amazed that on the campus 15 seminary students that the team approached during various breaks that 14 were unsure of their salvation. One of the 14 was a female childrens pastor that chose Christ and later came to thank the team for sharing. 3) A team returning from witnessing brought back a bag of drugs pictured

below right. The prospect was pregnant and coming out of a pharmacy when the team

approached her. She was headed home to commit suicide not have an abortion. She heard the Good News and received Jesus as her Lord and Savior and gave the team her drugs to dispose of.

Len and Daniele headed to their respective homes on Saturday and arrived on Sunday each looking forward to some much needed rest.






