Uganda

[LIRA, UGANDA] Pastor Len left Jacksonville, FL, on a set of 30-hour flights on Thursday, September 11, headed to Boston, then to Amsterdam, and ended up in Kampala, Uganda. After a six-hour nap at a hotel in Kampala, Len met up with Daniele and team (pic below right). The ten-man team headed north in a rented van for Lira, a city of 245,000 on Saturday, 9/13. After a six-hour drive, they arrived and checked into a newly built hotel. The manager, Isaac, was very receptive to the team and to the Gospel. Unfortunately, there was no internet and the electricity in the city was off for the next three days. Wednesday morning the team changed hotels. The second hotel had a backup generator and internet.

The five-day evangelism training started on Monday and went through Friday at the Essence of Christ Church. Each day consisted of about six-hours of lectures and two-hours of witnessing on the streets. The teams typically consisted of one trainer and two or three students. Interpreters were not much of an issue as the people spoke English, although the

dialect was a little hard to understand. Each night the 34 students had memorization to accomplish in preparation for the next day. By the fourth day the students were to have the presentation fully memorized, but some were not prepared for such work and dropped out of the class. On the fifth day the remaining 31 students took an oral and written exam where 15 passed.

Several witnessing highlights were: 22 homeless boys received salvation; 17 neighborhood children received a meal and Jesus; 117 school children and teachers came

to the church, heard Daniele present the Gospel, and 112 prayed to receive Christ; two children who killed a snake trapped in a latrine trusted in Christ. (Just ask Len to share these stories and pictures with you.)

Through Friday the class had shared the Gospel 260 times to 763 people with 560 professions of faith/assurances! (See "Just the Facts' on pg. 4.)

Saturday, the team returned to Kampala, and Len headed back to the USA.

Closing the meal time Cathy Russi played her guitar and sang a song about "Hope" that everyone enjoyed. Joe Hayworth, chairman of the LMI Board, followed and acknowledged various attendees: military, pastors, and the LMI board. Next he introduced semiretired businessman Doug Drelich who shared how his life has been wonderfully impacted as a result of attending the five-day evangelism classes in Jacksonville. Dan Houser followed (pictured on Pg. 1). He explained the Kairos prison ministry and LMI's involvement with the inmates.

Len Showalter took the stage and introduced Bishop Guy Landry and his wife, Galina, from Russia. After Galina briefly spoke, Guy delivered the main address exhorting all on Psalms 2. He informed everyone that the word "blessed" is "blazhen" in the Russian Bible. This implies an effort, work, or pressing into in order fully accomplish all that God has for us. He contrasted David and Solomon as an example.

Lastly, Beth Toenies closed the evening with a video of the ministry in Uganda and a testimony by Charles Obote, a businessman in Lira. Next, she asked all to participate financially to enable the ministry to continue impacting others around the world. Then she closed the evening in prayer.


