Armenia 1 & 2

[ARMENIA] Rev. Len Showalter headed to Yerevan, Armenia on June 13 and arrived at about midnight on June 14 after about 30 hours of travel. He was met at the airport by Pastor Hatchik of Living Faith Church. After a short wait for Len's luggage (which did not arrive for another three days) and for interpreter Nastya Radkova coming from Russia, they returned to Hatchik's church for a little rest. Also, coming from Russia was Pastor Guy Landry on June 15. Additionally,

four men drove from Guy's church to Armenia (3-days!) to join the team as trainers. After preaching in another church on Sunday, Len met up with the team in Abovyan at the Evangelical Church of Abovyan which was to host the training.

On Monday, June 16, 16 students arrived and Len shared the Gospel and 12 trusted in Christ! Then the teaching began with classes each day Monday through Friday 9am to 5pm and three witnessing opportunities in a nearby park. The classes concluded on Friday with exams. There were ten students that passed the Oral and the Written exams which were recognized at the graduation ceremony. The results of the week were that the Gospel was presented 71 times to 123 people and there were 68 professions and assurances of faith in Jesus Christ!

On Saturday, June 21, the team split up to minister in various churches. Len and Nastya went back to Pastor Hatchik's church to speak at their Sunday service. There were about 400 in a service comprised of one hour of Praise & Worship, one hour of preaching/teaching, and one hour

of praying for the people.

On Monday, June 23, 12 students arrived at Pastor Hatchik's church and started the evangelism training given by the six from Russia and Pastor Len. The class structure was the same as in Abovyan with classes from 9am to 5pm Monday through Friday with four witnessing opportunities in a nearby park. The classes concluded on Friday with exams. There were three students that passed the Oral and the Written exams which were recognized at the graduation ceremony. The results of the week were that the Ğospel was presented 48 times to 83 people and there were 65 professions/assurances of faith in Jesus Christ! All returned to their homes on Saturday, June 28.

[SAN PEDRO SULA, HONDURAS] On Saturday, July 26, Pastor Len, Rick Wyman, Lisa Simpson, and Melissa Liley, met at JIA at 5am and boarded a Delta flight to San Pedro Sula via Atlanta. The flights and connections were easy and

they arrived 11:10am (2-hour time difference). They were met by Hector and Lidia, Central America Director for Len Ministries. After a short drive and lunch they arrived at the Veranda Hotel located downtown. The team unpacked and rested a bit and met Pastor Santos Reyes and his wife, Sayra. Len preached on God's faithfulness at Pastor Santos' Jesus Vision Church on Sunday.

The 5-day class was held at a second church in San Pedro Sula Monday through

Friday 9am to 6pm. On Monday there were nine students including Pastor Santos, Sayra, and one of their daughters, Nayeli, who also served as an interpreter. The other six students were from Jesus Vision Church. After welcoming all Monday morning Len shared the Gospel and six of the students received Christ as Lord and Savior. The regular teaching began with the team taking turns in teaching the evangelism material. Each evening the students were released to return home to accomplish their homework assignments.

Overall the material is very comprehensive. The first day is dedicated to learning terminology and

developing an effective testimony. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday are given to memorizing the main points of a Gospel presentation along with two hours of practicum (witnessing) lead by the trainers which was accomplished at a local indoor mall. Friday the students took oral

and written exams as well as witnessing at the Central Park without any assistance from the trainers.

Graduation was held Friday evening with seven students successfully completing the

course. The witnessing results were: the Gospel was shared by the class 72 times to 111 people and there were 80 professions/assurances of faith in Jesus! (See the detail results on page 4
